Brock shared that the bond issuance for School Facilities District No. 2002-1, 2002 Election, Series B, will soon be sold through the District's Underwriter, RBC Capital Markets, in an amount not to exceed \$20 million. Based on the current time schedule, funds should be available the end of May/beginning of June 2006.

On May 15, two staff members will be added to our Facilities Department. They will assist with administering facilities planning for new school construction and modernization projects and they will begin attending the meetings starting in July.
